GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP

The Learning in Full Effect (L.I.F.E) organization offers Graduating High School Senior Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 - \$2,000 each to acknowledge the achievements of high school seniors and to assist them financially in their higher education.

AVAILABILITY

L.I.F.E scholarship applications are available to high school seniors beginning October 26 through April 4 of the current academic school year from Houston/Spring high schools. Scholarships are to be used during fall semester/quarter following high school graduation at an accredited college or university, community college or trade/technical school.

QUALIFICATIONS

This scholarship recognizes student achievement in the school and community and has a grade point average restriction:

Applicant must be -

1. a Texas resident;
2. graduating from a high school in Houston/Spring area and are in good academic standing with GPA 2.8 or higher;
3. 16 years of age or older and
 - a. a copy of applicant's school ID must be submitted with application.

APPLICATION AND DUE DATE

The application and accompanying reference forms may be obtained from:

The final application packet must include:

1. a completed application form;
2. a legible copy of applicant's current student ID photo;
3. a one-page essay describing
 - b. your career plans, goals, objective and any other information you feel would be valuable to the selection committee;
 - c. all school service-related activities;
 - i. including any service you provide to others in your school;
 - ii. without using abbreviations for any organizations listed;
 - d. your volunteer service in the community; (Do not include school activities listed in 3c, above.)
4. reference forms and letters in sealed envelopes;
 - a. reference form and letter written specifically for this scholarship application;
 - b. first reference form and letter completed by counselor (may not be related to student);
 - c. second reference form and letter completed by a member of the high school faculty; and
 - d. copies of recommendation letters for college admission are NOT acceptable.
5. copy of high school transcript

Mailing instructions:

1. Original application, and reference forms with letters must be submitted together in ONE submission.
 - a. Faxed submissions will not be accepted.
2. **The application must be received in the Learning in Full Effect, L.I.F.E office by close of business April 4th.**
 - a. Application will not be considered if received after due date or if any of the required materials are missing.
 - b. When April 4 falls on a weekend, applications are due in the L.I.F.E office by close of business the following Monday.

SELECTION

Recipients are selected by board members of the Learning In Full Effect L.I.F.E Scholarship and Grant Committee. All applicants will be notified of their standing by letter by the end of April. A check for the scholarship will be sent directly to the accredited college or university, community college or trade/technical school. Only recipients will be notified of their scholarship and additional information may be required.

FOLLOW-UP

Scholarship recipients must provide proof of enrollment and completion of coursework to the Learning in Full Effect LIFE organization by July 30th.
